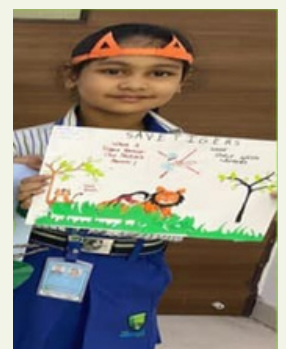
Tiger's Day

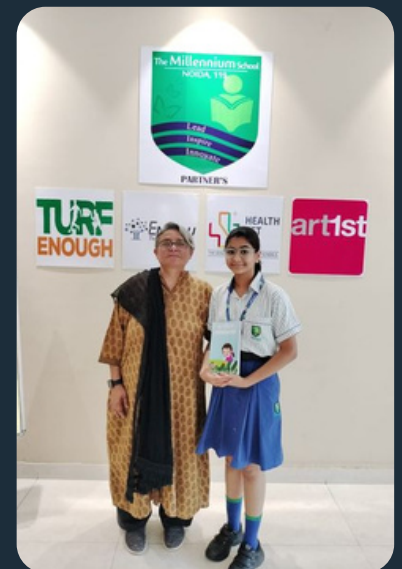
INTERHOUSE SPORTS COMPETITION

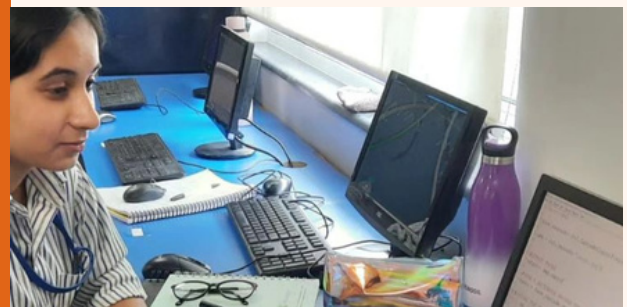
